



Tin Alley Netball 2017 Spring – Semester 2 Information Sheet



Thank you for registering your interest to be a part of the Spring (Semester 2) Tin Alley competition in 2017. The following notes are important points all participants and team captains must be aware of;

Cost

The registration fee for entering the competition is \$150[^] per team and must be paid upon return of your team registration form to Melbourne University Sport. We accept cash, EFTPOS and major credit cards (except American Express) [^]Register and pay before Friday 7th July to receive \$50 off team registration fee.

Teams are then required to pay a **'weekly game fee' of \$70 per indoor team and \$65 outdoor** at reception before taking the court. *Note – teams wishing to pay the whole season fee can do so after the conclusion of grading (round 3) by contacting the Tin Alley Coordinator. Season fee is TBC pending entries.

Pending number of entered teams the following competition start and match dates will be observed:

Monday 31 July – Outdoor Mixed Competition only

Tuesday 1 August – Outdoor Mixed Competition only

The MUS Stadium Policy must be read, agreed to and adhered to by all participants. It contains important information on the smooth running and the administration of the competition. The Tin Alley Netball rules should also be noted by team captains as it contains important points as per competition structure.

Competition grading

Teams will be graded across the first 2 rounds of competition. Pending results, teams will try to be graded against teams of similar skill for the duration of the competition. Teams may be re-graded during the season.

Registration requirements and Sign on

All participants must complete an online registration form before taking the court; they will then be named on the weekly sign on sheet. All players must be named on this sheet.

All players are required to **'Sign on'** at reception prior to taking the court – all players must meet the minimum number of matches played to participate in finals as stated in MUS Stadium Policy. Any player not signed for the required number of games will not be eligible to participate in finals as per the Stadium Policy.

Insurance

Melbourne University Sport does NOT provide personal accident insurance cover for participants in the competition. MU Sport recommends that ALL participants in the competition have arranged their own private health insurance, including ambulance cover. By taking the court, any participants in Tin Alley Netball agree to these terms.

All games will be played in the East and West stadiums at the Melbourne University Sports Center, Tin Alley, Melbourne University (Melway Ref 43 G3) Please check the roster of matches available on the Tin Alley Sport Website or the Community Sport notice board and website closer to competition start date for game time and court.
