## It's time to compete!

UniSport Nationals will be held in Perth this year between the  $24^{th} - 30^{th}$  September. We are aiming to take a large team of student-athletes to compete against the other 43 Australian universities. The UniSport Nationals is Australia's largest annual multi-sport event, competing in over 24 different sports. The aim of this update is to provide all the information you need to prepare yourself to represent the University of Melbourne.

#### **Uni Nationals Sporting History**

The University of Melbourne are currently National Champions in Women's AFL, Men's and Women's Fencing, Women's Surfing, Women's Touch Football, Women's Table Tennis, Men's Volleyball and Women's Badminton. These victories were secured in the last Uni Nationals event that was held in the Gold Coast 2019. The Uni Nationals is our highest level of competition we compete in, and many of our teams will have our elite athlete program scholars representing the University. The unique aspect of this year's competition will be that many of our student-athletes will be competing at their first UniSport Nationals event.
