If you would like to leave a **fixed amount** in your Will for the general use of the MUBC Future Fund, we suggest you use the following wording:

'I give (insert amount) to The University of Melbourne of Grattan Street, Parkville, Victoria ABN 84 002 705 224 specifically to support the Melbourne University Boat Club Sub-fund within the Melbourne University Sport Foundation' as currently governed by UTR 7.281.

If you would like to leave a **percentage** of your Estate in your Will for the general use of the MUBC Future Fund, we suggest you use the following wording:

'I give (insert percentage) of my residuary estate to The University of Melbourne of Grattan Street, Parkville, Victoria ABN 84 002 705 224 specifically to support the Melbourne University Boat Club Sub-fund within the Melbourne University Sport Foundation' as currently governed by UTR 7.281.
